

# ORGANIC

## WHAT TO THROW

Remains of food, old bread, remains of fruits and vegetables, eggshells, coffee grounds, tea filters, paper napkins, spoiled food, cut flowers

## HOW

Confer organic waste in the brown container, compulsorily using biodegradable bags and compostable



# UNSORTED

## WHAT TO THROW

Everything that can not be differentiated, laminated paper, the result of the sweeping of the rooms, rubber, diapers, etc.

## HOW

Placing the waste in the gray container, using any bag



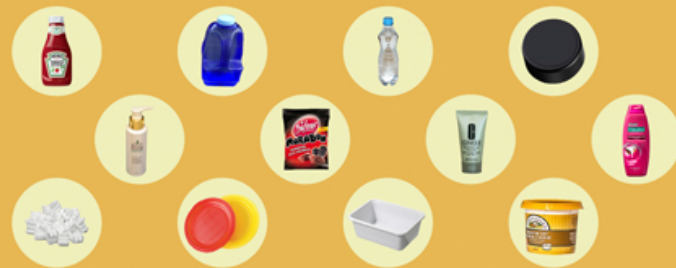
# PLASTIC

## WHAT TO THROW

Plastic bottles, liquid bottles for detergents, household products or personal hygiene products, rigid or flexible containers for food in general (for example, powdered food, cream cheese, ice cream), lids, films, bags

## HOW

place the waste in the yellow container, after cleaning or rinsing



# GLASS

## WHAT TO THROW

Empty bottles and glass jars, aluminum cans (drinks, beer, etc.), ferrous cans and cans.

## HOW

Place the debris in the blue container after cleaning and removing any cork or metal stopper.



# PAPER

## WHAT TO THROW

any type of paper provided it is not greasy, newspapers, books, various cards, flyers, boxes, Tetra pak with acronym CA

## HOW

empty and folded cartons placed in the white container









## THERE ARE 3 SIMPLE STEPS TO STORE WASTE:

### 1 - PRESS THE START BUTTON



### 2 - TOUCH WITH THE BLUE ECOTAG



### 3 - OPEN THE COUNTER AND DELIVER THE WASTE
